Youth Info

General Information: Our youth ministry program is for 6–12 grade students and college students. We have several programs offered every week that are age specific for our different age groups. We also have many special events during the year including missions trips, retreats, ski trips, outreach projects, fun nights out, and much much more.

6th Grade Students:

The 6th grade students have three different programs that happen every week. They are:

Sunday School: We have Sunday school classes in the upstairs of the education building. We offer classes at 9:30 and 11:00. The 9:30 class is for only 6th graders, but the 11:00 includes the rest of the middle school students.

Sunday Night: FUSION!!! This is our 6th grade confirmation program. This is a fun time of fun, fellowship, and learning. This program begins at 5:30 with snack supper (\$2). The Fusion meeting is from 6:00–7:30.

Wednesday Night: The 6th grade students join the rest of the middle school students for a Bible study at 6:45 until 7:30.

Middle School Students (7th–8th Grade):

The Middle school students have three different programs that happen every week. They are:

Sunday School: We have Sunday School classes in the upstairs of the education building. We offer classes at 9:30 and 11:00. 6th graders attend our 11:00 middle school class.

Sunday Night: This is a large group program that begins at 5:30 with a snack supper (\$2) and fellowship time. We begin our youth meeting for the night in the Attic at 6:00 and end at 7:30. We have fun nights out, games, worship, messages, and outreach projects during this time.

Wednesday Night: Our middle school choir (Spirit Choir) meets from 6:00 to 6:45. We have a Bible study starting at 6:45 which ends at 7:30. The middle school students are then given a chance to study during a study hall time which takes place in the Attic from 7:30 to 8:30.

College Students:

We have a college Sunday school class that meets at Star Bucks off 41 south. This group meets at 11:00 to discuss topics that are relevant in the lives of college aged students. We also have some special programs throughout the year offered to college students along with leadership opportunities with the youth program.

High School Student (9th–12th Grade):

The High School students have three different programs that happen every week. They are:

Sunday School: We have Sunday school classes in the Attic (youth room) at 9:30 and 11:00. These classes are usually discussions on hot topics from a Biblical perspective or a Bible study.

Sunday Night: This is a large group program that begins at 5:30 with a snack supper (\$2) and fellowship time. We begin our youth meeting for the night in the Attic at 6:00 and end at 7:30. We have fun nights out, games, worship, messages, and outreach projects during this time.

Wednesday Night: We have Hang Time at 6:00 in the Attic until 6:45. This is a time to just hang out with friends. We begin our Bible study at 6:45 which lasts until 7:30.
