ADULT CLASSES AND BIBLE STUDIES

We invite you to participate in these studies that are held on Wednesday evenings. They are spiritually enriching as well as practical in application. The studies, with one exception, will last for one hour, dismissing at 7:15 PM. Following Registration Night on Wednesday, August 11th, the classes will begin on Wednesday, August 18th.

Beginning Handbells: Led by Vicki Frey, this group is open to all who would like to learn the basics of handbell ringing. This group will meet in Room S112, downstairs in the Sanctuary Building.

Disciple Bible Study III: Remember Who You Are: The DISCIPLE Bible studies are very effective group studies. Jami Andrews, a veteran instructor of DISCIPLE curriculum, will lead this 32 week study. This class will meet in Room E202 and will begin at 6:30 and conclude at 8:45 PM. The cost of \$30 includes the study manual.

Men's Fraternity – Winning at Work and at Home - This study, led by Newt Hendrix, is designed to help the participants evaluate their life through the mirror of your family as well as the mirror of your vocation. We meet in Room E208. The cost for the workbook is \$10.

Positive Christianity – Rev. Brian Butler will lead this class through the study of the book *Don't Sweat the Small Stuff* and other texts, which will lead you to understand the potential you have for a positive Christian life. This class will meet in Room E106, and the cost for the book is \$10.

Study of the Sacraments – Rev. Don Landen will lead this class in a concentrated study of the sacraments of the church; the Lord's Supper and Baptism. This class will meet in the Conference Room, located in the Office Suite. The cost of the books needed for this class will be \$20.

The Spirit Filled Life – AUMC Lay Leader Leigh Halbrooks will be leading this study of I Corinthians, I and II Timothy and Titus from this popular study series authored by Jack Hayford. This class will meet in the "Room Down Under" the FLC.

**All programs will continue during double choir rehearsals if numbers are appropriate for large group programs.

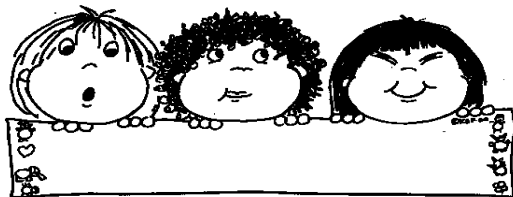
